WELCOME TO OUR 2008 SHOW SEASON!

Happy Spring!

So another show season begins! We hope everyone is working feverishly to get their horses, and themselves, ready for our first show! This year we will kick off our show season on **Sunday**, June 1st (not Saturday). Although it will be a normal show day there will be no payback for this day, as there usually is on Sundays.

There are a few changes to the show bill this year and this includes adding three more Walk/Trot classes. Walk/Trot is now a full division and will be receiving the same year-end awards as the Youth and Adult divisions. We are so happy to see that there are so many entrants in Walk/Trot! We hope our Walk/Trot riders will enjoy having more classes to show in. We have also added a Pre-Green English Pleasure class. Unfortunately, due to lack of entries, we have removed Hunter Hack from our showbill for the 2008 season. If there is enough interest in these classes, they may be put back on in 2009. Finally, English Pleasure, Pleasure Type and English Pleasure, Stock type have been combined to form English Pleasure Open. The same changes have been made to the Western classes as well—we now have Western Pleasure Open. This change was necessary due to low entries in the Pleasure type classes. Again, this change will be reviewed again for the 2009 show season.

We have also changed a few of our show dates. As you may have noticed, the first show is held in June, not May. This means there are two June shows. The July and August shows are held the same weekends as last year. We hope that this schedule will work out well for everyone.

Instead of including all required forms for the shows in this newsletter we have made them all available on the internet, including Membership, Entry, and Stall Reservation Forms. If you are unable to access the forms via the internet please feel free to contact Julie McKenzie and she will ensure that forms will be mailed to you. This gesture will allow us to keep our costs down and retain resources for more important things like PRIZES.

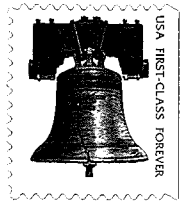


